The Alpha Gamma Delta Foundation's mission is to provide support for education, philanthropy and leadership, and thanks to supporters like you, there are many ways we fulfill this mission.

- **Why should my chapter fundraise for the Foundation?**
 - Because it feels good to help others give back! Your donations help our communities and their fight against hunger, helps sisters experiencing emergency need, provides leadership training and programs and supports academic success.
- **What does the Foundation do with our chapter's donations?**
 - It depends on the purpose of your event. Use the **Remittance Form** to tell us how the funds were raised and how they should be designated!
 - If "Annual Fund" is noted on the **Remittance Form**, your gift supports the mission and work of the Foundation and is directed to the area of the greatest need. Many of the Foundation's Annual Fund programs are listed below:
 - Fighting Hunger Grants - Provided to organizations that serve some of our most vulnerable populations.
 - Scholarships - Awarded each year to full-time undergraduate and graduate students.
 - Continuing Education Grants - For part-time graduate students and alumnae of Alpha Gam pursuing professional development.
 - SIS Grants - Confidential support to sisters experiencing chronic financial hardship. SIS Grants support sisters who have exhausted all other resources and cannot pay for life essentials, such as food, shelter, employment critical transportation and medical needs. (italicize the following:) This program does not assist in paying Fraternity dues.
 - Disaster Relief Grants - Providing assistance to sisters faced with immediate emergency needs due to a disaster, such as, hurricanes, tornadoes, floods and other natural disasters.
 - Scholastic Achievement Awards - Awarded annually to the senior(s) in each Alpha Gamma Delta chapter who maintains the highest cumulative grade point average during her college career.
 - Empower Path of the Epsilon Pi Journey - An optional experience for the most exceptional collegiate women. The cohort model is designed for collegiate members interested in a more in-depth personal and professional development opportunity.
 - Mental Health Support - Continue to provide chapter consultations, mental health training and holistic wellness programming via the Elevate Path of the Epsilon Pi Journey.
 - Leadership Consultant Program - Alpha Gamma Delta's Leadership Consultant Program exists to provide direct support to the Fraternity's collegiate chapters and members through intentional programming, personalized coaching and leadership development.
