APPRECIATED STOCKS

When you make a gift of appreciated stocks before calendar year end, you may avoid capital gains taxes and receive a tax-deduction for the full market value of your gift. Be sure to plan ahead when using appreciated stock to make your gift!

QUALIFIED CHARITABLE DISTRIBUTIONS (QCD)

Using a QCD is a tax-savvy strategy allowing individuals 70 ½ or older to transfer up to \$100,000 per year from Individual Retirement Accounts (IRA) directly to a qualified charity, like the Alpha Gamma Delta Foundation.
